## Read 100 Books Before High School for Future Success!



Middle School students can get started now building for their future! The 100 Books Before High School program is available for students in grades 6-8. It was created because reading is essential...it is a great way to build a solid foundation for everything else that you do. Believe it or not, the more you read, the more likely you will be to succeed in high school, in college, and into adulthood.

This program is an easy way to keep track of all the books you are reading in class and on your own. There aren't any rules for what you can and can't read, but you should try to read at your level. There isn't a rush. This program is meant to take years to complete...not months. So take your time!

Students can pick up their booklet at the Kendallville Public Library at any time. As a bonus, for every 10 books you read, you can pick out a reward.

Plus, don't forget about our 200 Books Before Middle School program, open to upper elementary students in third grade and up.

## Request an Item for Library Purchase



Did you know that we have a form specifically for your requests? We call it an "Orange Card" (because we print it on orange paper), but you can call it anything you want! The important thing is that you know it is available any time you want to request an item that we don't have.

Here are a couple of scenarios where these might be beneficial to you.

- There is a new book out, but the Kendallville Public Library doesn't own a copy. Other Evergreen Indiana libraries do, but because it is a new item, there is a 6 month wait before it can leave its home library. Request the book!
- You're looking for a DVD, but not only is it not available at the Kendallville Public Library...it can't be found anywhere within the Evergreen Indiana consortium. Request it!

We purchase as many of these requests as possible, but please understand that sometimes an item is out of print or rare, and the cost to purchase it might just be too great to justify the use it will get. But it never hurts to ask!

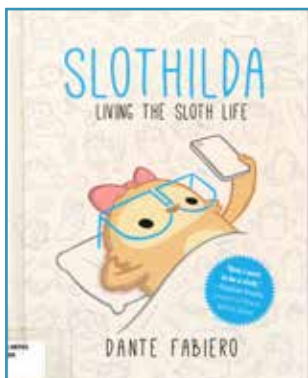
