Contest Guidelines:

- You may use an artificial or real pumpkin
- No Carving
- If your entry starts to rot or ooze, it will be discarded
- Pumpkin must be at the library by closing on Saturday, October 22
- Nothing too gory
- One entry per person
- Prizes will be awarded for age and type categories
- Be creative! You can use paint, paper, beads, feathers, markers etc.
- Do not put your name on your pumpkin, it will be assigned a number
- Pick up your pumpkin by Saturday, October 28, or it will be discarded
